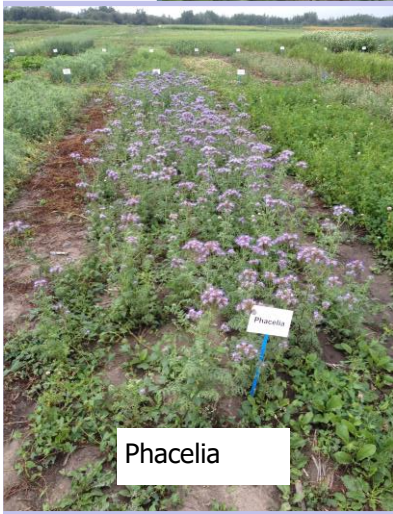


# CROPS GARDEN

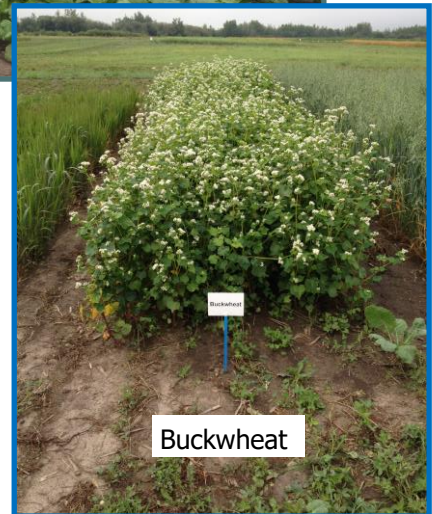

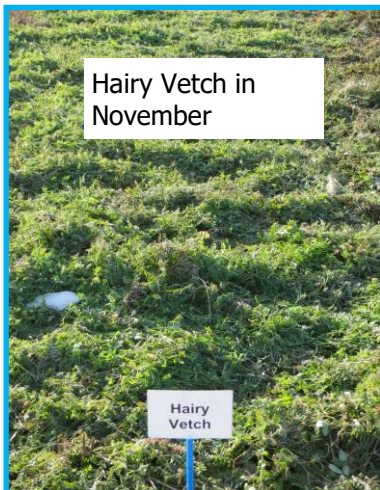
